January Meeting Minutes

Forty-Six people attended the January meeting at Boomer Jacks. Walter opened the meeting thanking and recognizing the great attendance and our new member and those members that came from a long way. Larry Gunnell, members, was able to come to the meeting from Wichita Falls, TX. Our new members were Gary Young and Ron & Mary Young, and our guests were Richard Klein and Matt & Donna Howell.

Walter presented the calendar of meetings developed by the NTVT board. The members made several suggestions and a final calendar will be released with the newsletter. The board asked for people to volunteer to be hosts for each meeting. Many meeting hosts have been filled but several remain open. The hosts would be responsible for communications with the location for attendance.

Jan asked the people going on the Alaska cruise next to stay for a short status meeting.

Brian Carron, the south-central regional director, gave a presentation on behalf of the VTCI, our parent organization. Brian noted that the VTCI board has committed to an international convention in the south-central region in 2025. The six clubs in the region will be asked to support this effort with the VTCI board taking the lead. Each club will be asked to provide someone to participate in the planning and coordination of the convention. The NTVT board will be polled to gauge support for this effort and respond to Brian.

George Antochy announced that there would be no Yellow Rose Classic this July. The venue for the last few years is no longer available. The Mustang club is in conversations with venues for 2025 but no final spot has been set at this time.

Many of our long-time members will recall the Hutto family from Eastland, TX. Their daughter, Virginia, first joined NTVT over 10 years ago to learn more about her Bullet Bird which she, her fiancé, and her father planned to restore. She was young, excited, and full of life; Sadly, Virginia was killed at the age of 24 on October 14, 2013 in an accident on Ranger Hill. Her death, however, led to the rebuilding of that stretch of I20 making that area much safer so that future accidents like the one that claimed her life could be prevented.

The club supported her parents, giving them a lifetime membership in the club. Danny and Catherine attended the 2015 South Central VTCI Regional



Convention hosted by NTVT at the Sheraton Hotel in Arlington. While there, Catherine saw a thunderbird belonging to a visitor at the convention, and fell in love with it. Danny persuaded the gentlemen then and there to sell him the t-bird for Catherine.

Eventually, NTVT helped Danny and Catherine put on two Benefit Car Shows at their ranch in Eastland. Several members won great door prizes and everyone who attended enjoyed the Hutto's hospitality. Danny and Catherine became very active in raising, breaking, and training mules; they formed a company called Hutto Mules and Farming, which continues to operate today. Whatever Danny did, he did with gusto! He was known throughout the area as a generous and kind man, with a quirky sense of humor.



Resources For Retro Owners

James Oglesby showed us some Thunderbird books of his at the last meeting. These might be helpful to a lot of our members, so we took pics for those of you who could not be at the meeting.



The first book on the left is Insider's Secrets of the 2002-2005 Thunderbird, by Philip Wegener, with a 2018 copywrite date. It looks like it may be difficult to find, but it shows up on Ebay periodically.

The second book is Retro Thunderbird by Don Narus (for sale on Amazon for \$13.95); and the last one is Thunderbird, 2002 by Michael Lamm (also available on Amazon as a used hard-cover book from \$7.21 to \$16.80).

Retro owners especially might want to place an order. Keep those Amazon trucks going!
